**+ REMEMBERING OUR VETERANS +** Thursday, Nov. 11th, is Veterans Day. It is the official USA holiday honoring individuals who served or are serving in U.S. Armed Forces. This federal holiday came about to mark the end of major hostilities of WWI that ended at the 11th hour of the 11th day in November 1918. Over 1,000 St. Vitus Parishioners have faithfully served in WWI, WWII, Korea, Vietnam, and the Gulf Wars. Twelve years ago, Nov. 8, 2009, Bishop Edward Pevec blessed the **"Memorial Monument"** in the parish courtyard that commemorates the high cost of freedom, listing the names of the 43 parishioners who gave their lives in defense of the many freedoms we have in the United States of America.

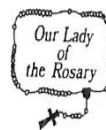

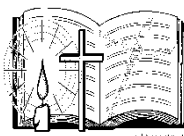
