PENTECOST

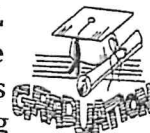

PENTECOST SUNDAY – Fifty days after Jesus rose from the dead, and ten days after He ascended into heaven, Jesus fulfilled His promise to the Apostles--the promise that He would send them a helper from heaven who would inspire and lead them in the task of spreading the Gospel. Thus, on Pentecost Sunday, while the Apostles and Mary were gathered in prayer, a most startling event happened. The place where they gathered for prayer shook from top to bottom. A fiery burst of light enveloped them all, and tongues as of fire came to rest on each one present. They were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in foreign languages. And when a large crowd of foreign pilgrims who were in Jerusalem for the Jewish feast of Pentecost came to the place, they inquired what was happening. The Apostles came out to them and began to speak of Jesus Christ the Messiah. On that day, many were converted to Christ.
