If you are not feeling well or have a temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher, please stay home. Hand sanitizers and masks are available by the main and west entrance (by the handicap ramp) of the church. As of July 22nd, masks are mandated in the State of Ohio until further notice. We will inform you if this changes. All door handles and pew surfaces are being cleaned and sanitized between Masses. Daily public Mass at St. Vitus Village Chapel has resumed. Those attending, please wear masks. The dispensation from obligation to attend Sunday Mass remains in effect until further notice for those who are not able to come to chuch.
