

Fasting & Abstinence Guidelines

All between the ages of 18 and 59 are to fast on Ash Wednesday (February 26, 2020) and Good Friday (April 10, 2020). All who are 14 and older observe abstinence on Ash Wednesday and each Friday of Lent. All others are encouraged to fast and abstain in ways appropriate to their circumstances.

Fasting means one full meal each day with the other meals not equaling a full meal. Eating between meals is not allowed, but liquids are allowed. Abstinence means that no meat is allowed. If health or ability to work would be seriously affected, one is not obligated to fast or abstain.


