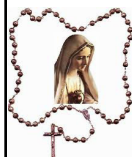

Twenty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time
Weekend of August 29/30, 2020

In today's Gospel reading, Jesus brings up the
topic of the cross to his followers. They would not
