

SPIRITUAL LIFE - SACRAMENTS

Abstinence Regulations

Every Friday during Lent is a day of abstinence.

ABSTINENCE is observed by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence, no meat is allowed. Note that when health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige. When in doubt concerning fast and abstinence, the Parish Priest should be consulted.

Abstinencia durante la Cuaresma

Todos los viernes durante la Cuaresma son días de abstinencia.

LA ABSTINENCIA de carne se observa por todos los católicos mayores de 14 años.

Tome en cuenta que cuando la salud o la capacidad para trabajar se ven seriamente afectadas, la ley no le obliga. En caso de duda sobre el ayuno y la abstinencia, se debe consultar con un sacerdote.

¿Qué debemos nosotros transformar en esta Cuaresma?

"Este es mi Hijo, el Amado, escúchenlo". (Marcos 9:7). Si recordamos, al ser bautizado el Señor, se escucharon palabras desde el cielo que decían. "Tú eres mi Hijo, el Amado, mi Elegido". (Marcos 1:11). En ese momento de su bautismo iniciaba su misión, ahora, en el momento de la Transfiguración inicia su recorrido hacia Jerusalén para vivir su Pasión ya cercana. La fiesta de la Transfiguración, marca prácticamente la Cuaresma como recorrido de arrepentimiento y conversión. A lo largo de estos cuarenta días, la Iglesia invita a sus feligreses a un cambio. La palabra transfiguración, significa un cambio de forma y revela su verdadera naturaleza y cultura. En este caso se revela la verdadera naturaleza divina de Jesús.

¿Qué debemos nosotros transformar en esta Cuaresma? ¿Qué cambios hubo en la forma de vivir después de la pandemia? Toda transfiguración tiene un recorrido de metamorfosis. La Vida Pasión, Muerte y Resurrección de Jesús, vislumbran el futuro nuestro. También, significa que no somos de este mundo, somos peregrinos, avanzamos a una vida nueva que podemos empezar a vivir ya desde aguí en la tierra. Últimamente, con todos los acontecimientos que la humanidad ha experimentado a raíz de la enfermedad y falta de trabajo, se espera que por lo menos a causa de estos, las personas se den cuenta que Dios es el que lleva el control y debemos escucharlo como hijos-hijas amados por él. Mantengamos esta semana esta palabra. Escuchar, a la familia, escuchar al hijo-hija, al amigo. El consejo del Papa Francisco es el siguiente. "Escuchad a Jesús. No lo olvidéis". (16 de Marzo 2014). **©LPi**

As we approach tax season, I am reminded of the old saying: Nothing is certain but death and taxes. Each of us spends some time in preparation for the latter. How much time do we give to considering the former? What is eternal life?

The Psalmist comments on the brevity of life stating: We finish our years with a sigh. The length of our days is seventy years or eighty for those who are strong (Ps. 90). What of your days? The older we are the swifter the years pass. What is that brief candle we call life in comparison to eternity?

Spend some time in this season of repentance to examine with me what Christ has revealed about what we call the four last things: death, judgment, hell and heaven. We cannot live well if we do not look at where we are going. The epitaph on the tomb of Blessed Duns Scotus reads: He died well because he died before he died.

As a reminder, our goal is to raise the funds that will address our critical needs, including:


- Paying off our Diocesan loan to partially construct part of our new Parish Life Building, estimated at \$825,000;

Making History

We are thrilled to announce two parish teens, Ashley Chittum and Madelyn Reed, have officially joined the inaugural class of female Eagle Scouts, making history both in South Carolina and nationally. They are members of our St. Mary Magdalene Troop 420G, part of the Blue Ridge Council.

"It's an incredible accomplishment to become an Eagle Scout, a distinction that could never be obtained by a female until now," said Heidi Dannelly, scoutmaster for Troop 420G. "All of our scouts take their duties to God and Country very seriously. I'm so proud of Ashley and Maddie and look forward to seeing many scouts from our troop follow in their footsteps."





To obtain the Eagle Scout rank, both teens needed to complete the same requirements as their male peers, including significant projects for their communities.

Ashley Reed's Eagle Scout Project was building a dog agility course at Concerned Citizens for Animals in Simpsonville, the oldest no-kill animal shelter in the Upstate.

Madelyn Chittum's Eagle Scout Project was building two fishing ports at YMCA Camp Greenville. The fishing ports make fishing more accessible to campers of all physical abilities.

We are proud of Ashley and Madelyn for all they have accomplished.

Troop 420G was founded in August 2019 with five scouts and has grown into a troop that now includes 15 young women from age 11 to 17. They have completed community service projects, backpacking trips, and outdoor survival training. The older Athena patrol is currently training for a 12-day wilderness trek at the Philmont Scout Ranch in Arizona and the younger Artemis patrol is looking forward to summer camp at the Blue Ridge Council's Camp Old Indian.


