



### Do You Know Jesus?

Included in the study is a "Jesus Timeline Chart" which provides a visual overview of the life and ministry of Jesus Christ, from the Annunciation of his birth to his Ascension into heaven. The story of Jesus is faithfully recorded in the four Gospels, but it is sometimes hard to see how everything fits together. This chart helps by giving the big picture of Christ's life and showing how it all unfolds. The timeline . . .

**For independent study:** The full student set is \$33 and it includes the workbook, book and one-year video streaming access.


