**LETTER #10 TO THE WHOLE PARISH
FROM FATHER MARCELLO
IN THE MIDST OF THE CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC
MAY 19, 2020**

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

During the past week I have consulted extensively with parish staff members and lay leaders regarding how best to move forward with the **resumption of public worship at St. Catherine's** in a way that's **safe, consistent with state mandates and diocesan guidelines, and able to serve as much of the parish as possible.**

We have considered the various possibilities for offering Mass in an *outdoor* setting that would 1) be limited to fewer than 50 people at a time, 2) require registration through an online reservation portal which also would provide for contact tracing, and 3) include a safe and efficient manner of distributing Holy Communion in such a way that the health of the one receiving, as well as the one giving Holy Communion, would be protected as much as possible.

The strong consensus that emerged in all these consultations is that, for the time being, we should continue doing what we're doing now, until such time as we can welcome more than just a fraction of the parish to weekend Masses.

As context: during normal times, our weekend attendance averages around 1,300 or 1,400 people over the course of six Masses. Holding three or even four outdoor Masses on Sunday mornings would still allow us to accommodate **only a small fraction** of that in an outdoor, socially distanced venue, such as under a tent or with chairs set up in a field. (On Saturdays, the live-streamed Mass is celebrated in church at 4:00 p.m., and it still gets dark too early to have a 7:15 p.m. Mass outdoors). The "drive-in" option of cars in the parking lot was also considered, but it soon became apparent that it would be difficult for us to do this as prayerfully and well as we'd want to, given the complicated logistics and "moving parts" which such a scenario would involve. The unpredictable weather here in New England adds further concerns for outdoor celebrations.

When we can resume Masses **in church** for 50 people – which we hope will be within the next several weeks – we will also resume our normal Mass schedule, or something close to it, given the extra time involved in sanitizing the church between Masses. At that time, we will be able to **simulcast** from the church into the Family Center and possibly into the Church Hall, and to provide Holy Communion safely in all three locations. This will allow us to serve 600 and, if the Church Hall is also possible, up to 900 people per weekend.

We pride ourselves on being a parish that's welcoming and inviting. No matter how you slice it, outdoor Masses would only be able to serve a small portion of our community, and we'd almost certainly find ourselves having to turn people away. **I'm just not comfortable doing that.**

I'd much rather wait until we can have Mass in church and simulcast to our other locations on campus, and provide Mass **safely**, and in a way in which we'll be able to **serve much greater numbers** than we could accommodate outdoors, while also **ensuring the necessary reverence** for the Holy Mass and the Blessed Sacrament. I respectfully ask your patience and understanding as we look forward to that day.

Throughout this time **we will continue uninterrupted** with live-streaming Masses on weekdays and weekends. The church will remain open for private prayer on weekdays, and we will continue to offer Confession and Eucharistic Adoration at various times during the week. This will also give us a chance to see what happens once Connecticut opens up a bit and to make any adjustments necessary to ensure the safety and well-being of everyone, and the **smoothest transition possible** under these challenging circumstances.

My friends, I know I join you in saying that **I'm very much looking forward to having the community of St. Catherine's back together for Mass**. There is no question that this has been a time of suffering in being away from each other and from the reception of Christ in the Holy Eucharist. Yet, when we factor in the various challenges of returning to worship in a way that preserves the health and safety of the clergy and faithful, and respects the integrity and reverence of the Church's liturgy, it seems clear to me, to the parish staff, and to lay leadership that the best course of action for us at St. Catherine's is to keep doing what we're doing now - which is **going very smoothly**, given the circumstances - until we can resume public worship in a way that's **safe, prayerful, and inclusive of more than just a fraction of our parish community**.

Finally, but **very importantly**, I'd like to share with you a matter for which I ask your prayers: since the end of April, **Father Bochanski has been away from the parish**, staying with his parents at their home in New Jersey. His dad, George, is unexpectedly facing some serious health issues, so Father will remain with his parents for the time being to help and support them. When he's able to return to the parish, I'll let you know. In the meantime, **please keep Mr. Bochanski and the entire Bochanski family in your prayers**.

- **Daily Mass** livestreamed Mon- Fri at 7:30 a.m. and available on demand for the rest of the day.
- **Confession** Sun 12:00 noon to 2:00 p.m. in the parking lot and Tue 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. in the Family Center. No Saturday confessions.
- **Eucharistic Adoration** Sun 1 to 3 p.m. in church; Tue 6 to 8 p.m. in the Family Center; Thu 6 to 8 pm in church
- **Church open** for private prayer Mon - Fri 8:15 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
- **Other resources** are posted to our YouTube channel. Links are included in our regular email update blasts, as well as on our website, www.stcathtrumbull.com

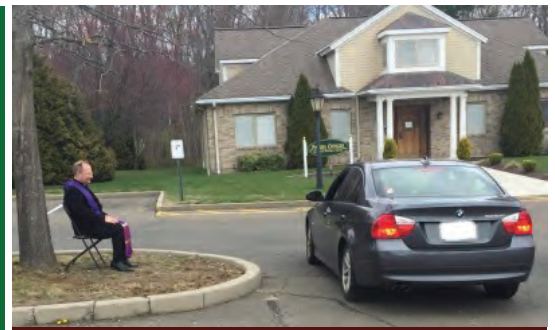
A huge THANK YOU

NEXT SUNDAY'S GOSPEL: PENTECOST

Next weekend's Sunday Gospel reading is provided here, so that we can think and pray about it, and be ready to receive it into our minds and hearts when it is proclaimed at Mass.

On the evening of that first day of the week, when the doors were locked, where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you." When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. The disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained." *John 20:19-23*



Music Ministry:

During the Easter season, the post-Communion meditation hymn each weekend is the *Regina caeli* chant. This ancient chant melody is one of the four seasonal Marian antiphons that traditionally is sung at the end of Compline (Night Prayer).

The *Regina caeli* is sung from Easter Sunday until the Solemnity of Pentecost, and the text expresses Mary's joy at the resurrection, as well as the importance of her intercession, particularly during this time of global pandemic.

Pray for us to God, alleluia.*

How to Get the Most from a Livestreamed Mass

The intentionality you and your family put into preparing for and participating in the Mass dramatically affects the impact it has on you and others. This is true under normal circumstances, but it is true even more so now, when we must participate in Mass remotely.

Pick a designated time your family will "go to Mass." Let them all know, and stick to that time.

Dress up for Mass as you would if you were going to Mass in church.

Prepare the space in which the Mass is viewed. Light candles. Place a crucifix in a prominent spot.

If the space under or near the TV has distracting items such as video game consoles,

etc., cover them with a white tablecloth.

Do not eat for one hour before Mass begins.

If you have holy water, pass it around before Mass and encourage each family member to make the Sign of the Cross with it, just as we do when we enter the church building.

During the Mass, participate in every physical gesture you normally would in church: standing, kneeling, sitting, etc.

Be as pious as possible, and refrain from gestures and other forms of communication that wouldn't normally take place during Mass in church.

Leave your cell phones in another room and mute them during Mass.

Print out the hymns for the Mass and sing along as you would in church.

If you have a surround sound system, *use it*, so that the experience is more like being in church.

Respond out loud at every point you normally would in church.

When the readings are proclaimed (except for the Gospel), consider having family members proclaim the First Reading, the Responsorial Psalm, and the Second Reading. Simply mute the TV during that time. Since the Responsorial Psalm is sung in church, you will more than likely finish the readings before they are finished in church. When done, simply turn the sound back on.
