

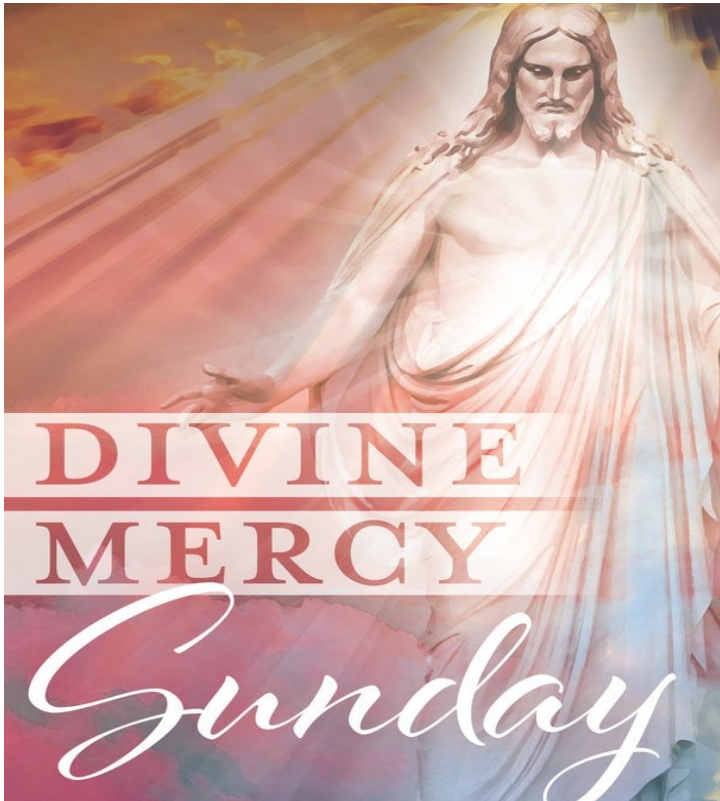

Have mercy on us and on the whole world.

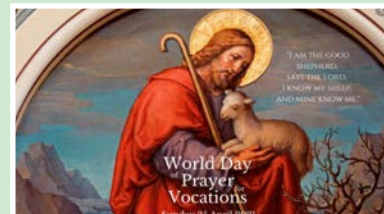


Earth Day Thursday, April 22

This is the world's largest recruiter to the environmental movement, working with more than 75,000 partners in over 190 countries to drive positive action for our planet.

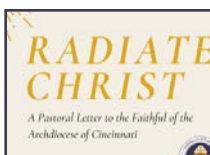

From the Pastor



I have always found Thomas' story to be consoling and filled with hope. For most of us, our path to faith in Christ includes times of doubt and confusion.

The gift of Thomas is that he has the courage to speak out about his anger and lack of faith once he hits rock bottom and doesn't know where to turn. When we have hit rock bottom because of a shattered marriage, a death in the family, a loss of a job, or isolation, the world around us may seem to be crumbling.

In these times we may cry out in anger and doubt. Thomas stands for all of us who travel the road of faith and run into speedbumps of uncertainty and doubt.

Notice that Jesus respects Thomas' honesty and met him in the midst of his uncertainty and doubt. Thomas teaches us that it's ok to cry out to God in anger and doubt. It is precisely in these moments that Christ meets us right where we are as well.

Living the Resurrected Life

The story of Doubting Thomas in John's gospel is the one we hear through all three of the liturgical-cycles on the second Sunday of Easter. Some think that people of faith do not have doubts but theologian Paul Tillich talks about it being the dynamic element with our faith. Like in many deepening and growing relationships there are a succession of challenges to be met along the journey of faith.

From the introduction of the Gospel, we learn that the disciples were already gathering together on the "first day of the week." Their reason for gathering may not have been the noblest (for fear of the Jews) but they were there together, except Thomas. Jesus meets them right where they are and tells them twice, "Peace be with you." After commissioning them he "breathes on" them. This word appears only once in the entire New Testament but it reminds us of the second creation story when God breathes on Adam and gives him a life-giving spirit (Genesis 2:7). It also recalls breathing into dry bones in Ezekiel 37 that animate and form the Israelites once again after the exile. This is very good news.

We are called to share in Christ's ministry of peace and reconciliation in a broken world. Are we ready to take the first step?

In so many ways God is opening our eyes and ears, even during Covid. If you or someone you know are interested in finding out more about God and His Church, contact us and we will meet you where you are to aid you in your journey of faith.
