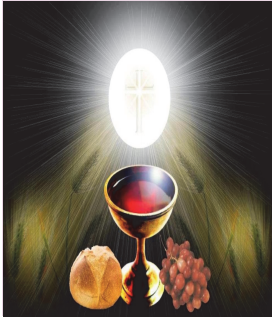

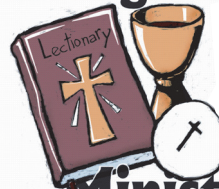

The Giving Tree



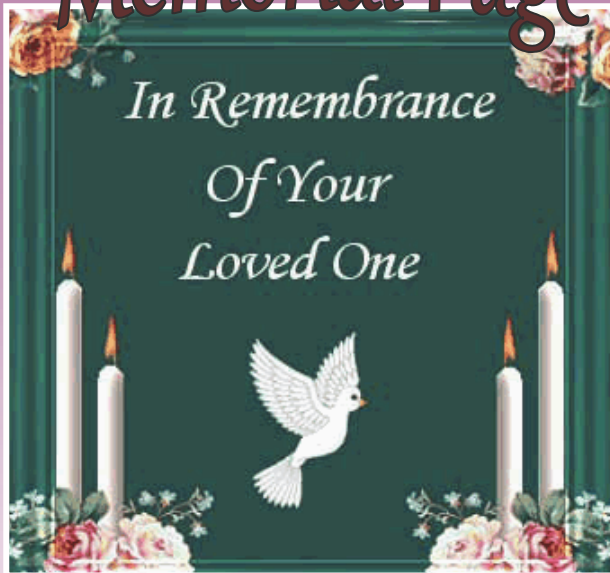
Helping Those in Need
