

O Sacrament most holy, O Sacrament divine. All praise and all thanksgiving be every **moment Thine!** Once we pass into June, summer is here. We pay attention to all the joys of this season of nature, warm weather, time to be outside and everything else that we love about these months. Catholics know that we also live in liturgical time, the seasons set by the Church's worship and devotion. June is a month that is filled with great celebrations of Faith. Today, the Sunday that follows Trinity Sunday is designated The Body and Blood of Christ, traditionally called Corpus Christi. Monday, June 24th, is the Solemnity of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist. Nativity means Birthday, so happy birthday to the Lord's Precursor! But there is more...The Friday following Corpus Christi is the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. This feast is all the more special because it is the titular feast of our Parkston parish (our community is named after this feast!). Finally one more...June 29th, is the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, again the titular feast of the Dimock parish.

Summer can be tough with extras in the parish schedule. But these feasts invite us to pray for our communities, our families, our world, our clergy and religious, and so much more.

- Monday, June 24th, the Nativity of St. John the Baptist, I will celebrate and Extraordinary Form (Latin) Mass at Dimock at 8:30 AM. All are welcome and resources to follow along will be available.
- Friday, June 28th, the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, we will celebrate a Mass at 8:30 AM (note the time difference!) in Parkston. Following the Mass, I invite the Christian Faithful to sign-up for a time of Eucharistic adoration before the Blessed Sacrament. This adoration will conclude with Vespers and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament at 6 PM.
- Saturday, June 29th, Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, Mass will be celebrated in Dimock at 8:30 AM. Following the Mass, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed on the altar. I ask the Christian Faithful to take advantage of this special time of thanksgiving and petition. We will conclude with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament at 12 noon.

The month of June should remind us of the beauty of summer of a South Dakota summer and the great feasts that remind us why we love our Catholic Faith.




Sacred Heart Parish is in need of a Secretary and Director of Religious Education
