June 9, 2019

Come, Holy Spirit! Fill the hearts of Your faithful! Today is Pentecost, the great feast of the Holy Spirit. Today I invite us to reflect on and pray for a renewed outpouring of the Spirit on our families, our community and parish.

Every Christian receives the Spirit, becomes a temple of the Trinity, on the day of his or her Baptism. It is the Holy Spirit, poured out by the risen and ascended Christ, that makes us a living creature. No dry and lifeless bones, but a beloved child of God, living life to the full. A parish that is alive and vibrant with living families and disciples.

Sacred Heart Parish: We are in a time of some changes and disruption. May I share some thoughts and perspective?:

- At present we without an office manager. That means that not everything will run perfectly smoothly all the time. Please know that for now I am taking on the work of the bulletin, scheduling of Mass intentions and other office administration. If I forget something, or get something wrong, please let me know....but could I ask in charity, please be patient.
- Note that I will post on the parish office doors and weekly bulletin the office hours of that week (when I will be in the office, taking appointments and answering phones). You will also see that my cell phone continues to be in the bulletin and personal email. Use as is necessary. If you don't get me on the phone, leave a message and I will get back to you in a timely manner. Do remember that my typical day off is Monday—however I will now be in the office on Monday morning to ensure that counting of the weekend collection.
- The liturgical schedule is complete and posted for June. Starting in July, I will have a weekly sign-up sheet for liturgical ministries for each Mass.
- Parish positions to fill: Office manager, approximately 2.5 days a week. Director of Religious Education, approximately 1.5 days a week. This week I will consult with our finance council and will have a fuller description of these two positions. Please reach out to me with questions on the positions.
- I take this very seriously: pray for the parishes, pray for your pastor and deacon, pray for our finance council and parish leadership, pray that we are faithful to the Lord in living the mission of a vibrant and living Catholic community.

"Luke says that the Spirit came down on the disciples at Pentecost, after the Lord's ascension, with power to open the gates of life to all nations and to make known to them the new covenant. So it was that men of every language joined in singing one song of praise to God, and scattered tribes, restored to unity by the Spirit, were offered to the Father as the firstfruits of all the nations. This was why the Lord had promised to send the Advocate: he was to prepare us as an offering to God. Like dry flour, which cannot become one lump of dough, one loaf of bread, without moisture, we who are many could not become one in Christ Jesus without the water that comes down from heaven. And like parched ground, which yields no harvest unless it receives moisture, we who were once like a waterless tree could never have lived and borne fruit without this abundant rainfall from above. Through the baptism that liberates us from change and decay we have become one in body; through the Spirit we have become one in soul." [From the treatise Against Heresies, by St. Irenaeus]


