

Dear Parishioners of Immaculate Conception, St Joseph, and St John Cantius!

Freedom? As Americans we assume that we understand this word very well. Our democracy is built on the ideal of freedom. A value that has been essentially equated with "choice". Traditional Christian teaching, however, has always seen it slightly differently. For Christians freedom is realized only in pursuit of virtue.

We are soon approaching Lent. Ash Wednesday is just fifteen days away! During Lent we are asked to practice a penance for 40 days. This is a difficult task. We are giving up a degree of 'choice' for something greater. What is this 'something greater'. It is virtue. We are hoping to form a habit (a virtue) of choosing the good by denying ourselves.

Last year my penance was to set my alarm at 3am every morning, get up, pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet, then return to bed. It was a very trying penance. It was challenging to break my sleep each morning, to leave the comfort of my bed, and to spend ten minutes in prayer on my knees. In this practice I was giving up the 'good of sleep' for a greater good. What was this 'greater good'? I can make some guesses, but in essence this 'greater good' was something only God knew.

For us Americans, freedom means opportunity and choice. Moral teachings, sacrifice, regular Sunday worship: these all seem to oppose our opportunity to choose. We feel that freedom is taken away by religion, because religion limits choice. The opposite, however, is the case. The sacrifices that lead to habits of virtue bring peace, balance, happiness, even elation. We begin to enter into communion with God. The mystery of His grace then acts upon us and provides insights and joys hitherto unimagined.

I encourage you to take your penance this coming Lent seriously. Be formed by God. Let him work on you. He can only do good in you. The opposite will occur when we ignore the call to penance. The avoidance of sacrifice always leads to lesser things. When we are humble enough to embrace the plan of God for our lives, a horizon of beauty and grace opens before us, filled with love beyond expression, breathtaking and immense in its goodness.

I look forward to seeing you at Mass on Sunday! Please encourage your family and friends to attend also. Untold graces are present at each and every Holy Mass. Thank you for the beautiful blessing of shepherding your parishes! I am definitely keeping you all in prayer!
