

Dear Parishioners of Immaculate Conception, St Joseph, and St John Cantius!

Lent is about Hope. The greatest hope of Lent is the discovery that every sacrifice we make leads us to a greater freedom in Christ. The notion that Lent is about hope may seem strange. However, this season points us to the victory we have with Christ on Easter Sunday. The season is not only about penance, deprivation, and spiritual struggles. It is also about hope. All of our sacrifices are necessary and vitally important. The penances, however, lead to the goal of our spiritual life, that of our lives being transformed and united with God in perfect charity. The many ways by which we encounter the Word of God in the forty days of Lent leads to the Hope offered in Christ. The hope of Lent lies in what God does. Our penances simply open us to the incredible work he wishes to do in us.

The exhortation which the Lord addresses to us through the prophet Joel is strong and clear: "Return to me with all your heart" (Joel 2:12). Why must we return to God? Because something is not right within us. We are all in need of conversion! It is a daily task. Lent once again makes its prophetic appeal, to remind us that with God it is possible to return with all our heart. God cannot deny himself. He continues to be infinitely rich in goodness and mercy, and he is always ready to forgive and make us new.

People often remark on the way our churches are filled on Ash Wednesday. It's not a holy day of obligation. No one is required to attend Mass or receive blessed ashes. But there's something about the beginning of this season of Lent that draws us in, calls us to austerity, to a change of heart and mind. That something that draws us is God's grace. And it is drawing us back to a deeper life with God. Lent doesn't take us away from our ordinary lives, but rather it invites us into a deeper relationship with Christ. ## **LENTEN REGULATIONS-Fast & Abstinence**

The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, March 6. Lenten regulations are as follows:

- 1. Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent, and Good Friday.
- 2. In addition to abstaining from meat, Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, until they celebrate their 59th birthday, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound to this regulation may eat only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.
