For in your penance God will bring into your life the abundance of His life. May your Lent lead to the Fullness of life. Penance always leads to a greater freedom, a freedom that allows God to work more abundantly in your life.

I look forward to seeing you at Mass on Sunday! Please encourage your family and friends to attend also. Untold graces are present at each and every Holy Mass. Thank you for the beautiful blessing of shepherding your parishes! I am definitely keeping you all in prayer!
