

Dear Parishioners of Immaculate Conception and St Joseph!

Back in the 1980's there was an anti-drug commercial featuring an old experiment in which a rat was placed in a cage with two water bottles. One bottle contained pure water while the other was laced with heroin or cocaine. The rat became addicted to the second bottle and drank until it died. Vancouver Psychology Professor Bruce Alexander, however, didn't think the rat kept drinking the drugged water solely because it wanted to. He hypothesized it drank the drugged water simply because it was in a cage and had nothing else to do (that he was bored). Professor Alexander would repeat the experiment but in a different environment he called Rat Park. This was a cage filled with toys, tunnels, food and, most importantly, other rats to play with. The rats were presented two water bottles, just like the first experiment. They tried the drugged water, but not one of them became addicted or died. Their happy environment, Alexander concluded, instead caused them to ignore the drugged water after drinking just a little of it.

This experiment can be extended to humanity. If we truly believe that we are made in God's image and likeness, then we should have an inexhaustible desire to do God-like things. Christianity does not call us to a diminished life, it calls us to fullness of life. If we do not find life in our relationships and our experiences, then we too will drink from the bottle poisoned with our favorite drug. If you are struggling with an addiction, recognize that you are searching for a God-like experience. You will never find 'it' in your addiction. The void you feel is only filled in authentic relationships and experiences.

An authentic Christian is a God-seeker. Piety is not a bland, monotonous exchange of mindless words and postures. Piety is an overwhelming response to Love, to the love encountered in and through prayer and relationship. Life-giving love comes from sacrifice, through the pouring out of oneself in love: to God and to others. Mystics are enraptured by the divine, not because they are self-absorbed navel-gazers, but rather because they are such great lovers, that their love is 'ecstatic' (out of body) in both their willingness to love and be loved.

This weekend we celebrate Pentecost, the coming of the Holy Spirit. The dynamic and ecstatic love of the Holy Trinity is the Holy Spirit. This love overflows into creation. God is not a distant, static monarch, unrelatable and remote. Rather, as the Father's of the Church describe, God is Love, and his Love is a perichoresis, a dance of Love that is eternally exchanged within Himself in the Holy Trinity.

Pentecost is a profound feast, meant to break us free from the 'poisoned bottle' of our earthly addictions. Pentecost leads to an overflowing encounter with God the Holy Spirit both in relationship and in experience. If we know the Holy Spirit, we will never 'be bored' and settle for something less than God. If we know the Holy Spirit, we will be driven to the greatest of Loves and the fullest of lives! Please do not hesitate to call. You are in my prayers. Trust always in Jesus. St Joseph, Patron Saint of the Universal Church – Pray for Us
