Part 4 Humility is authenticity

At the same time, truly humble people rejoice in the good of other people and in the greatness that surrounds them. They are completely free from inferiority complexes and from the need to compare themselves to others. Humble people are free; they don't have an urgent need for praise, recognition, or applause for their virtues, because they know who they are and that they have worth.

True humility, therefore, is a source of confidence, courage, and freedom. Humble people don't go begging for recognition and don't get discouraged when they don't get it, because their happiness doesn't depend on other people's opinion. By contrast, proud people are very sensitive to criticism and are easily wounded and discouraged. Chesterton considered humor as the natural foundation of humility, because those who can laugh at themselves are free of all pride.

Dear Parishioners of Immaculate Conception and St Joseph!

This coming weekend is filled with many blessings for our diocese! On Tuesday, June 23rd, Arturo Viguera, will be ordained a deacon. Many of you remember his time with us this last summer. Please keep him in prayer on this special day! He will serve as a deacon for the coming year as he prepares for ordination to the holy priesthood in the summer of 2021. Because Arturo is preparing for the priesthood, he will be ordained as a transitional deacon. (Every priest is first ordained as a deacon, then later a priest.) At his ordination will be five other men, each of whom will each be ordained as permanent deacons. Permanent deacons do much to assist the priests of our diocese in their ministry. These men will serve in various parishes, assisting at Mass, preaching, celebrating baptisms, etc.

On Friday, June 26th, a number of priests and lay persons will be attending the annual Chrism Mass at the Cathedral in La Crosse. This Mass is generally celebrated just prior to Easter; however, this year it was postponed. At this special Mass all of the oils used in Baptism, Confirmation, Holy Orders and Anointing of the Sick are blessed and dispersed to the parishes. Some of these oils will be brought back to our parishes and used for the Sacrament of Confirmation for some of our youth. Lucca D'Huyvetter and Jaden Rowekamp will both receive Confirmation on June 28th. Two of our other youth will receive the sacrament on July 4th. Please keep our students in prayer as they prepare for their sacraments.

Finally, on Saturday, June 27th, four young men will be ordained priests for our diocese. You can see their pictures in this bulletin. All of them were just beginning seminary when I was getting ordained. It is so wonderful to see them now becoming priests. In today's Gospel St John says, "What I say to you in the darkness, speak in the light; what you hear whispered, proclaim on the housetops." Please pray that these young men, along with all of us priests, may remain passionately rooted in our desire to share the saving message of the Gospel.

I am here if you are in need. Please do not hesitate to call. You are in my prayers. Trust greatly in Jesus as we continue through this difficult time. St Joseph, Patron Saint of the Universal Church – Pray for Us

Resuming Sunday Mass
Public Mass has resumed again on Sundays. There is no obligation to attend. The following guidelines will be helpful for those who plan to come.



Schedule

Sunday
- 8:30am - Mass at St Joseph (at 25% capacity) approx. 40
- 10:15am - Mass at Immaculate Conception (at 25% capacity) approx. 60
- 10:15am - FacebookLive Mass

Several points for attending Mass
1) We will still continue the Live Stream Mass. The time of the Live Stream will be at 10:15 am
2) The Sunday Mass obligation is not in effect. So it is not a 'sin' to miss Mass during this present time. However, you are still required to honor the Sabbath by setting that day aside for prayer and rest.
3) As Mass resumes, we will only be able to allow the churches to filled to 25% capacity. To accomplish this at St Joseph we will have half of St Joseph parish come one Sunday, and the other half come the following Sunday. At Immaculate Conception we will do the same thing: half of the parish will come one Sunday, and the other half the other Sunday. Thus you will be able to attend Mass every other week.
4) **Parishioners with a last name starting with the following letters are invited to participate in the corresponding Sunday Mass. There is no obligation to attend. This is simply an invite for those who wish to attend.**
June 28 - A-L
July 5 - M-Z
If it is not your week to attend Mass, you can still come and wait in your car. If the 25% limit is not filled, the ushers will invite you into the church.
5) Ushers will meet you at the front door and guide you to your pew. They will ensure proper spacing.
6) Masks are encouraged but not required. You can bring your own from home if you have one, or you can get one at Mass.
7) Gloves can be worn. But they must be removed when you receive Communion.
