

Dear Parishioners of Immaculate Conception and St Joseph!

At the end of June, we celebrated the Feast of St Peter and St Paul. The scriptures contain many details about these two individuals. For instance, there is the remarkable story found in the Acts of the Apostles of an angel liberating St Peter from prison. In the Letter to St Timothy, St Paul expresses his confidence in God, that after having competed well for his faith the crown of righteousness awaits him. Finally, in the Gospel of Matthew we hear the well-known passage where St Peter declares that Jesus is the Son of God. His name is then changed from Simon to Peter with Christ declaring that upon this rock Christ will build his church. St Peter then receives the keys to the Kingdom of Heaven, a text that is very prominent as scriptural evidence for the authority of the papacy. These three examples are just a few of the hundreds of examples where St Peter and St Paul are mentioned in Scripture.

In this two-part article I want to share some of the stories that have arisen outside of the Bible regarding St Peter and St Paul. My four years of studies overseas in Rome provided me with many opportunities to visit the places where St Peter and St Paul spent the last few years of their lives. The following stories are based on Roman tradition; therefore, they do not have the same weight as passages from Bible. However, it is good to hear the traditions that have been maintained regarding St Peter and St Paul to help us understand better their time spent in Rome.

A long-standing tradition provides details regarding the martyrdom of St Peter which Scripture alludes to in John 21:18. It is believed that St Peter was crucified upside down in the middle of an arena called Nero's Circus. This was a place where the Roman's raced horses. St Peter's Basilica was built directly over the spot of St Peter's burial and very near the actual site of his crucifixion. The bones of St Peter are currently in the confessio below the Papal Altar in the center of the basilica. This is the basilica that is often depicted on the news as it is the most frequent location for Masses celebrated by the Pope. CONTINUED NEXT WEEK
