Dear Parishioners of Immaculate Conception and St Joseph!

“Do not take but receive.” The first sin of Adam and Eve occurred when they took the apple from the tree. They did not receive this from God. Rather they took the apple and sought their own good, without God’s help.

God wants to give us good things. He wants us to receive good things. He doesn’t want us to take them. He wants us to ask for them, to pray for them, to wait patiently for them, and then to rejoice in receiving the gift from Him. Too often in our life we think we will be happy if we can just take something. If I can take this job, this career, this relationship. We say, “If I can just take this thing, then I will be happy.”

So if you want a particular good job. Bring this to prayer. Is this something God wants to give to you? Apply for the schooling you need. If doors open and God is confirming this in your prayer as your path, then he is blessing you. But if you push through, ignore God, and just try to take a particular path because you think it will make you happy, you will find in time that your pursuit will break you. That your happiness is not in what you take, but what you receive.

If you are young and want a particular boyfriend or girlfriend, ask God for help. Ask God to bring this special person in to your life. Ask God if you are called to be married or called to serve the church as a priest or as a nun. If you are called to marriage, bring God into your dating. Ask God to bless you with a good wife or a good husband. Be willing to wait for years for God to give you a good husband or a good wife. Just pray and trust in God.

So many times I see people in their forties or older who are in such sadness. In their twenties they just followed the culture. They dated, had many relationships, were promiscuous, eventually they married someone outside of the church. Never did they invite God into their search for a good husband or a good wife. They just took. They took relationships and lived selfishly. Then in their later years they are broken and sad. They live a life of loneliness. They have bad addictions. They are also very confused. They believe so many lies. They trust the culture and doubt the moral truths of Jesus Christ. We must pray and help these individuals. They seek help and spiritual care.

As Christians, trust in God. Trust his moral teachings. Be patient. Wait. Wait. Wait. Do not take something. Even if it means many years. Trust God. God will always bring beauty into your life. He has a plan for you and it is beautiful. The prophet Hosea in the Old Testament speaks of Israel and says, “They made kings in Israel, but not by my au-

2) The Sunday Mass obligation is not in effect. So it is not a 'sin' to miss Mass during this present time. However, you are still required to honor the Sabbath by setting that day aside for prayer and rest.

3) As Mass resumes, we will only be able to allow the churches to be filled to 25% capacity. To accomplish this, we will have half of the parishioners come one Sunday, and the other half come the following Sunday. Thus you will be able to attend Mass every other week.
