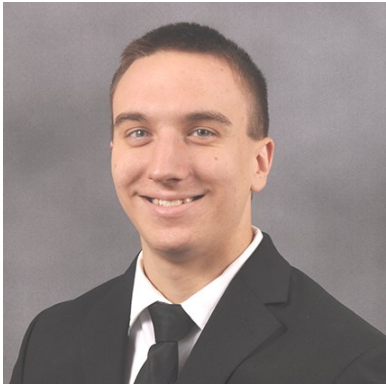
They also need people to work! People will be needed to run the food from the basement to the cars, and to help assemble the meals. We appreciate your donation and participation!

Hello to all parishioners of Immaculate Conception and St. Joseph!

My name is John Duranso. I'm a seminarian of the Diocese of La Crosse, and I will be spending a short amount of time with Fr. Dan in Alma Center.

I'm originally from Wausau, born and raised there (save for a 1-year stint in California when I was 8 years old). I graduated from Wausau West high school in 2016 and went straight into St. John Vianney College Seminary out of high school. I spent 4 years there and one year in La Crosse on the diocese's Regency program, so I've been a seminarian for the diocese for the last 5 years, with 4 more to go until I'm ordained a priest of Jesus Christ, so I'm over halfway through! This coming

Fall, I'll begin my first year at St. Francis de Sales Seminary in Milwaukee for my graduate theology studies.

Over the course of the last 5 years I've had some amazing opportunities, including the chance to spend a semester in Rome! A little closer to home, 2 years ago I spent a summer in Neillsville with Fr. Varkey (God rest his soul), and was present when he officially installed Fr. Dan as pastor at Immaculate Conception.

Over the past couple years I've been discerning with some different religious orders who have a greater focus on silence and solitude than most diocesan priests can afford, so I ask for your patience and your prayers, since I can be easily overwhelmed when I have to get to know a lot of new people. That being said I can say with greater confidence than ever that God is calling me to the diocesan priesthood.

Thank you all for your warm welcome! I'm looking forward to the time I'll get to spend with all of you in Alma Center and Fairview, however brief it might seem!
