

Dear Parishioners of Immaculate Conception and St Joseph!

The Fear God is the Beginning of Wisdom according to the Book of Proverbs. In the Sacrament of Confession, a person is forgiven when they demonstrate either perfect or imperfect contrition. Imperfect contrition is sorrow due to fear of eternal punishment, perfect contrition is sorrow due to love of God. Of the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit, the seventh is the gift of the Fear of the Lord.

Fear of God has spiritual merit. The fear of God can be understood from a perspective of awe. A person can be overwhelmed by the grandeur and immensity of God. This can inspire reverence within a person and lead the person to a deeper relationship with God. However, fear of the Lord can also be a more basic movement, akin to fearing danger and punishment. Fear of God, however, is always rooted in love. It is a beginning to a deeper encounter with freedom and authentic love.

You who are parents. A child may not be aware of danger. For instance, if you live close to a street, the child may not understand the danger presented by a passing car. Out of love you try to explain the danger. Yet the child may still not understand. Thus out of love you express the situation in terms of fear of punishment. You may say, "If I ever see you on the street, you will have to clean dishes for three nights in a row." A child responds to this threat by taking the danger more seriously. The child will in time understand the danger of passing cars. However, in the meantime a healthy fear, is the beginning of wisdom for the child.

This threat by the parent is an act of love, as it serves to protect the child from potential hazards. God does the same thing. What is the greatest threat to human beings? What should we fear, but often we do not fear? The answer to this question is sin. Sin destroys authentic life in our soul. Sin spiritually kills our soul. Like my previous example with children near passing cars, we often cannot see the danger in sin. We cannot see that when we place ourselves in a potentially sinful situation we are risking death to our soul. Sin, in particular mortal sin, kills the life of grace within our soul and God wants to protect us from spiritual death. This is why deadly sin is called mortal sin, because it causes a mortal wound, killing the life of grace within our soul.

Yet we have incredible hope. The prophet Micah says that God delights in clemency. God delights in forgiveness and mercy. Just like a parent delights in a child who turns from bad behavior, God delights in the ability to forgive us. Since God is all powerful, he is also all merciful. Fear of the Lord is our protection. It leads to our salvation. God loves us too much to ever let us play on a dangerous street, God loves us too much to ever let us alone and be in danger of
