Dear Parishioners of Immaculate Conception and St Joseph!

In the Book of Revelation, Saint John sees a scroll with seven seals. No one is able to open the scroll but the Lamb, Jesus Christ. All heaven falls down before the Lamb and they sing a new song, as incense and worship fill the heavens. “Worthy are you to receive the scroll and to break open its seals, for you were slain and with your blood you purchased for God those from every tribe and tongue, people and nation.” (Rev. 5:9) It is interesting to note that this scroll was written on both sides. (Rev. 5:1) What other document from God was written on both sides? ... The Ten Commandments. (Ex. 32:15) Thus an indication that this scroll was of equal importance to the great law given to Moses. Just five chapters later in the Book of Revelation another scroll presented. We understand that this scroll is meant for all of us. It is described as smaller in size and it is already opened. A voice cries out, “Go, take the scroll that lies open in the hand of the angel...take and swallow it. It will turn your stomach sour, but in your mouth it will taste as sweet as honey.” (Rev. 10:8-10)

We hear a nearly identical passage in the Book of Ezekiel in the Old Testament. God speaks to Ezekiel, “Son of man, eat what is before you; eat this scroll, then go, speak to the house of Israel. So I opened my mouth and he gave me the scroll to eat...I ate it, and it was as sweet as honey in my mouth.” (Ez 3:1-3) This scroll, like the Commandments, is written on both sides. Both Saint John and the Prophet Ezekiel are then commanded to speak the words of God to the people. The psalms say, “How sweet to my tongue is your promise, sweeter than honey to my mouth.” (Psalm 119:103)

When we listen to the word of God, it often sounds sweet. However, when we begin to live it authentically, it often turns bitter. The Word of God is sharper than a two-edge sword, slicing between bone and marrow. Thus it roots out our attachments to vice. The Word of God purifies us so that we can be free in our ability to love, to become authentic images of Christ in His freedom. If we have Faith, we know that the temporary bitterness of God’s purifying Word is a blessing.

These passages culminate in the greatest gift that we have as humans, the gift of the Holy Eucharist. At every Holy Mass, we ‘take and eat’ the Holy Eucharist, just as Saint John and the Prophet Ezekiel ‘took and ate’ the scrolls. In the Holy Eucharist we receive the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, who is in himself the Word of God. Thus by receiving the Holy Eucharist we receive the Word of God. This last week we celebrated the First Communions of several of our children. The gift that these children received and that each of us can receive (Continued on page 2)

(Continued from page 1) when we approach God in the state of Grace, is communion with God. By receiving Jesus in this way, one receives quite literally the Word of God. God has called us friends; he has invited us into an intimate relationship with himself. We are not meant to only read the Word of God; we are meant to also receive him substantially in our hearts. Holy Communion, therefore, is the pinnacle of God’s expression of Love.

You may be experiencing bitterness, sadness, despair, heart break. When we receive the Word of God, we receive it with joy. However, this joy is often followed by the bitterness of a cross. We may wonder why our fidelity to Jesus leads to sorrow. But through Faith we can see beyond the horizon. The sadness of today will pass. The Word of God purifies and heals. Purification lasts for a time; however, the healing remains. As the dawn rising in the sky, our spiritual life becomes filled by authentic freedom and love, casting away all previous attachments and difficulties.
