

Dear Parishioners of Immaculate Conception and St Joseph!

On the fourth of August of this year, an explosion occurred in Beirut, Lebanon, devastating the city. The explosion was so powerful that the land shook, equivalent to a seismic event of magnitude 3.3. When I heard the news of this explosion, I immediately thought of a passage from Ezekiel. (Ezekiel 28:1-10)

> To the prince of Tyre: Thus says the Lord GOD: Because you are haughty of heart, you say, "A god am I!

And yet you are a man, and not a god, You may think yourself like a god. No, you are man, not a god, handed over to those who will slay you.

The ancient city of Tyre is about fifty miles south of Beirut. Thus, the reason why I thought of this passage. The city of Tyre is mentioned numerous times in the Bible. One of these mentions occurred just this last weekend during the Sunday Gospel. A Canaanite woman from the region of Tyre and Sidon, asked Jesus to heal her daughter. Jesus said "It is not right to take the food of the children and to throw it to the dogs." The woman however persisted in her faith, and Jesus healed her daughter saying, "O woman, great is your faith!"

The city of Tyre was always depicted as the antithesis to Jerusalem. Tyre was a city of wealth. It was pagan and without knowledge of God. Yet according to the Gospel of Matthew it is this city, despite its unbelief, that would first receive mercy before all the cities of Israel. "Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! For if the mighty works done in you had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes." (Matt 11:21)

A verse in Deuteronomy echoes the passage from Ezekiel, 'Our own hand won the victory; the LORD had nothing to do with it.' (Deut 32:27) This passage could be the motto for our age. How often I sit on the porch of my rectory praying Rosaries or the Psalms. I see the cars and tractors, trucks and vacationers zip past my front window. No one stops by the church to say Hi to Jesus. Everyone is busy with their daily life, few seem to even acknowledge that their wealth and prosperity is a gift from God most high.

In our developed and prosperous nation, are we not like Tyre? We boast of our riches and ignore our churches.

There is one difference between us and Tyre. Tyre did not know God, they did not have any churches or structures in place to worship and adore our Lord. Here in America we have the entire infrastruc- (Continued on page 2)
