Dear Parishioners of Immaculate Conception and St Joseph!

This weekend we hear from the prophet Isaiah, “My thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways my ways, says the LORD. As high as the heavens are above the earth, so high are my ways above your ways and my thoughts above your thoughts.”

These words of Isaiah speak to the transcendence of God. Within our Church we have a beautiful ancient Latin hymn called the Te Deum, which echoes the words of praise by Isaiah. As priests we pray this prayer every Sunday and on every Solemnity. This rich prayer praises the truths of the Holy Trinity and recalls that God’s ways are far above our ways. Despite the transcendence of Isaiah’s words, we know that God revealed himself in and through the Incarnation providing us with the gift of knowing the profundity of the Trinity through the relatability of Christ in the Flesh.

You are God: we praise you;
You are God: we acclaim you;
You are the eternal Father:
All creation worships you.
To you all angels, all the powers of heaven,
Cherubim and Seraphim, sing in endless praise:
Holy, holy, holy, Lord, God of power and might,
Heaven and earth are full of your glory.
The glorious company of apostles praise you.
The noble fellowship of prophets praise you.
The white-robed army of martyrs praise you.
Throughout the world the holy Church acclaims you:
Father, of majesty unbounded,
Your true and only Son, worthy of all worship,
And the Holy Spirit, advocate and guide.
You, Christ, are the king of glory,
The eternal Son of the Father.
