Eden Sacred Heart Parish Cemetery Board Meeting: We had this meeting last Thu., Jan. 16th to review and approve the final draft of Sacred Heart Parish cemeteries (St. Michael, St. Joseph Eden Park, and St. Joseph Lake City) policies and procedures. These were approved pending editorial review. They are effective immediately and will be promulgated soon. They will be available in the church entrances, posted at the cemeteries, and provided upon purchase of grave burial rights. Effective immediately, each grave burial right is \$250 for parishioners and non-parishioners. Grave digging for urns is \$75.

Eden Parish Library: The books and VHS tapes at the parish hall are going to be discarded. If you are interested in taking any of them, please do so by Feb. 4th.

January 22nd Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children: The General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM), no. 373, designates January 22nd as a particular day of prayer and penance, called the “Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children”: “In all the Dioceses of the United States of America, January 22 (or January 23, when January 22 falls on a Sunday) shall be observed as a particular day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion.”
