### LENT REGULATIONS FOR CATHOLICS

Jesus said to the disciples of John and the Pharisees: "Can the wedding guests mourn as long as the bridegroom is with them? The days will come when the bridegroom is taken away from them, and then they will fast." (See Matthew 9:14-15)

- All Fridays through the year, especially during Lent, are penitential days.
- Abstinence: All who have reached their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday are to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and on all Fridays of Lent.
- Fasting: All those who are 18 or older, until their 59<sup>th</sup> birthday, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting is one full meal and two lesser meals without eating between meals.

**Grenville All You Can Eat Fish Fry:** This will be the Fridays of Lent except Good Friday, **Feb. 28<sup>th</sup>**, Mar. 6<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup> and Apr. 3<sup>rd</sup>. It will be in St. Joseph Parish Hall serving Pollock, shrimp, cheesy hash browns, baked potatoes, coleslaw, salads, fresh baked bread, rice pudding, homemade desserts, lemonade and coffee from 5:00 p.m. – 7:30 p.m. Cost is \$11.00 for adults, \$5.00 for kids 7-11, and free for kids 6 & under. The fun includes a gun raffle, 50/50 drawing, and weekly kid prizes!
