How to Prepare for Divine Mercy Sunday: On Divine Mercy Sunday (April 11) our Lord promises "the complete remission of our sins and the punishment that goes with them" if we properly observe this feast.

To do so, we should: 1) Celebrate the feast on the Sunday after Easter. Go to Mass that day, pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, and thank God for His mercy. 2) Sincerely repent of all our sins. 3) Place our complete trust in Jesus. 4) Go to confession preferably before April 18. (Cardinal Macharski, Archbishop of Cracow Poland and protector of the Diving Mercy message and devotion, stressed that "our confession for Divine Mercy Sunday should tke place before the day itself if possible, preferably during Lent.") 5) Receive Holy Communion on Divine Mercy Sunday. Venerate the Image of Jesus of Divine Mercy. This means spending time in prayer or performing an act of deep religious respect toward the image because of the person it represents, in this case, our most merciful Savior. This can be done in front of the Divine Mercy Image, or at home with a a Divine Mercy prayer card. Be merciful to others, through our actions, works and prayers on their behalf.


