
Sacred Scripture is used to listen to what God is tryingto communicate to the one praying.

Letter from the Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ,

Emily Clark, who serves as our Coordinator of Youth and Young Adult Evangelization (CYE), has decided to move on to the next adventure in her life. She will officially resign from her Staff position in mid-January and move to Denver, Colorado. Emily has been our CYE since February 2019 when she was hired during the last semester of her college studies at OU. A big part of her ministry has been with our Confirmation students, coordinating their formation to receive this important sacrament. Emily has also been a huge help with our social media outreach, especially during the eight months since the coronavirus pandemic struck Oklahoma. Emily created and regularly updated a "COVID-19" page for our website. She has livestreamed many Masses and other events and has trained volunteers to do the livestreaming in the new church. She also has been in charge of the monthly Facebook Live which I do. Meghan Christopher and Emily have teamed up to publish an informative and fun monthly parish newsletter, "Gifts of the Spirit." Deacon Paul has worked closely with Emily to improve our parish's communication efforts. He and I and all the other members of our Parish Staff have been blessed to work with Emily. She will be greatly missed by us and by many others. A Search Committee will soon be formed to search for candidates for our CYE position.

Sometime later this week, if you are signed up for Flocknote, you will receive a **Christmas Mass survey**. Since this Christmas will be unlike any other we have experienced. I need your feedback on a Christmas Mass schedule, so Masses can be offered which will effectively spread out the Mass attendance. Because of the Archdiocesan COVID-19 regulations, only 290-300 people can be seated in our new church building for Mass, which includes people viewing the Mass on the TV's in the gathering area and hallways. If we have more than 290-300 attend Mass, the old church would be used as an "overflow," and a Communion minister would be sent there to distribute Communion. Since the highest attended Mass at most parishes is the first Mass on Christmas Eve (ours is usually at 5 p.m.), Archbishop Coakley is giving permission to pastors for this year only to schedule Mass on Christmas Eve as early as 2:30 p.m. When you receive the survey, you will see an option for a 3 p.m. Mass and a 5 p.m. Mass on Christmas Eve afternoon. If you want to receive important information from our parish through Flocknote emails, register at hsccmustang.flocknote.com., or by way of text messages, then text "hsccmustang" to "84576."

Our newly formed "*Maintenance and Property Committee*" met for the first time in September. Its members took a walk-through of the new church building on Oct. 11th and another walk through of all the rest of our parish buildings---old church building, Pavilion Classroom building, rectory—on November 7th. They are prioritizing needed repairs as well as regular maintenance items. Hermilo ("Milo") Franco is the chair of this committee. Thanks to all who helped make and sell tamales in October and to all who purchased tamales. \$4200 was raised for our new church fund through this annual fundraising event.

The Solemnity of Christ the King November 29, 2020 Matthew 25, 31-46

The end of the Church's year comes next weekend, and we are reminded by Matthew that there will be a judgment. To focus on reward and punishment with the Gospel is to miss the point. The judgment is not really a decision made at that moment. It is a ratification of a whole host of decisions made throughout one's life. Once Christ has become the center of our lives, once the Gospel and its Beatitudes has become the rule of our lives, the judgment begins in our favor. Matthew suggests that there is a consequence to freely willed human action; that they are known to God, and the love or lack of love in such actions is always going to be considered. The feast of Christ the King has nothing to do with monarchs or monarchies and everything to do with God's sovereignty in human life. This is a feast has little to do with crowns and civil trappings, but much to do with Christ as the center and all-inclusive power in one's life. Soon it will be time for Advent, and the mood of anticipation will come over us. Let it not be a pretend anticipation about the birth of a child, but rather the anticipation of the judgment that can go in our favor if we are ready.


