The Vocation Tree ~ Frequently Asked Questions

Aren't all Christians consecrated at baptism? It seems the word consecrated is being used in many different ways in the Vocation Tree. The term consecrate means 'to set aside for a sacred use'.

The Vocation Tree reflects three distinctions of the term "consecrated" in reference to vocational calls:

- ~ A Christian is consecrated at his or her baptism, that is, set aside for God alone.
- ~The Church also refers to the state of *consecrated life* as a particular call stemming from the baptismal consecration, a call which involves the setting aside of a particular person as one who is to live as Christ himself..... chaste, poor, and obedient.
- ~ Within the state of *consecrated life*, there is the particular vocation of Consecrated Virginity Lived in the World. In this particular vocation, the consecration sets the virgin aside as a sacred person in the Church, one who is given the title *bride of Christ*, a title she shared with the Church herself.
