By means of a three-year systematic formation process, participants are empowered to live and share their faith in Jesus Christ with those they encounter in their daily lives. Equip is attentive to all four areas of discipleship formation: a thorough knowledge of Church teaching, a deep personal prayer life, an ability to interact with and accompany others, and a recognition of the personal call and empowerment to build up God's kingdom. The Equip process consists of quarterly Saturday meetings and regular contact with a mentor to focus on the basics of the participant's spiritual life and assigned reading for the other areas of formation.

The Vocation Tree ~ Frequently Asked Questions

What about members of third orders; how do they fit into the Vocation Tree? Members of third orders (sometimes called by other names) embrace the spirituality of a particular religious tradition, such as Carmelite, Franciscan, Benedictine, Ignatian, or Dominican.

Traditionally, "first order" refers to the masculine branch of a religious family; "second order" refers to the feminine monastic branch of a religious family; and "third orders regular" refers to those in active religious communities. "Third orders secular," known commonly today simply as "third orders," are associations of laity, and sometimes diocesan priests, who embrace the spirituality of a particular religious tradition while remaining in the state of life in which they have been living.

It might be pointed out that the Vocation Tree artist has signed her name, "Mrs. Jennifer Ward, O.P." indicating that she is a married woman following the Dominican spirituality in her married life.
