

# CLARIFICATION FOR WHAT TO DO AT COMMUNION TIME!

According to the Diocesan guidelines, the faithful will:

- STAND during the distribution and reception of Holy Communion for the singing of the Communion Hymn. (General Instruction of the Roman Missal, 50, 124, 128)
- KNEEL during the period of sacred silence after the distribution of Holy Communion. This period of silence should begin as soon as the distribution of Holy Communion has been completed. At this point the faithful may sit or kneel.
- The faithful are not required to stand during the purification of vessels, or until the reposition of the Blessed Sacrament (GIRM, 43).

#### MASS INTENTIONS

The practice of requesting a Mass to be offered for loved ones, living or deceased, is a beautiful and wonderful part of our Catholic tradition. The offering is \$10 per Mass. If you would like a Mass said, please come to the parish office during regular business hours 9:00 am - 5:00 pm, Monday through Friday, and we would be happy to assist you.

- 1. We do not currently have any Masses available in 2021. If the current weekday schedule continues, we will add more 8:30 am Mass Intentions in November.
- 2. The Mass Intention book for 2022 is now open for 7:30 am weekday and weekend Mass Intentions. Once the current weekday Mass schedule is evaluated, we may also be able to schedule 8:30 am weekday Mass Intentions.

#### **IGNATIAN THREADS**

Peter Faber was from the French region of Savoy, born into a family of shepherds, unable to afford any formal education. Knowing Peter's desire to study for the priesthood, his parents sent 10-yearold Peter to a small school sponsored by their parish priest. He entered the University of Paris in 1525, where he and his roommate. Francis Xavier. studied philosophy and theology. In October, 1529, they added a third roommate, a man several years older than themselves. This new man. Ignatius of Loyola, was known to have a positive effect on the people with whom he came in contact. While Ignatius served as Peter's spiritual guide, Peter helped Ignatius with his difficulties in learning Greek and with other academic matters. Peter was uncertain about what career path he should follow. With Ignatius's guidance, he decided to become a **IGNATIAN** priest. Peter made the Spiritual Exercises with Ignatius just before Threads his ordination.




