## LITURGY CORNER

Today is the Fifth Sunday of Lent. “In the Dioceses of the United States, the practice of covering crosses and images throughout the church from this Sunday may be observed.” And thus, San Clemente Church will observe this practice. It is a way of helping us to concentrate on these last days of Lent. Note that at one time Holy Water was removed from the church. This practice is not permitted, especially from the Baptismal Font. The season of Lent is not only a penitential time but is a season rich in the symbolism of water and baptism. It is also a time when we, the faithful, are encouraged to frequent the sacraments, especially Penance and Eucharist. Dipping our hands into the Holy Water and making the Sign of the Cross reminds us of our Baptism. During this week we are preparing, along with the angels and saints, for Jesus’ entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday and for his Passion, Death, and Resurrection, the Triduum. Next Sunday is Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord. We will walk with Jesus as he enters Jerusalem to accomplish his Paschal Mystery. The opening procession with the palms will draw us into Jerusalem as well and begin Holy Week, leading us into and through the Triduum and, ultimately, to Jesus’ triumphant Resurrection on Easter Sunday. The Gospel for Palm Sunday is “The Passion of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Luke”. We will participate in this Gospel. (Be aware that the Gospel on Good Friday will be chanted this year and so our participation will be to listen.) *Gay Snell*

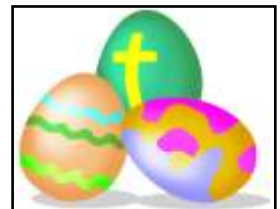
