LITURGY CORNER

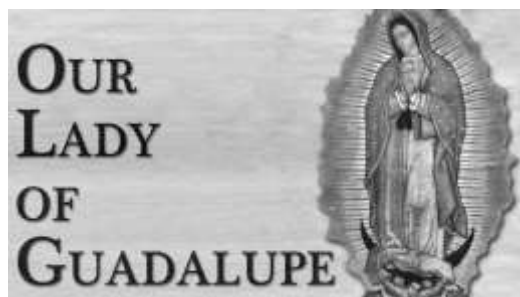
On December 12 we celebrate the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. It is not considered a Holy Day but is an important feast day. On December 9, 1531, Juan Diego, an Aztec, encountered a beautiful young woman near Mexico City. She spoke in his native language revealing herself as “Holy Mary, Mother of the True God for whom we live.” She requested that a chapel be built. The local bishop refused to believe San Juan Diego and so the Virgin herself arranged roses in San Juan Diego’s cloak. When he opened his cloak to give the bishop the roses, a miraculous image appeared. The chapel was built and many were converted. Pope Pius XII declared Our Lady of Guadalupe patroness of all the Americas, and her celebration on December 12 was raised to the rank of feast for all countries of the Americas in 1999. It is customary on this feast day to sing Las Mananitas and to gather for fellowship. For many years, San Clemente has kept this tradition...celebrating Mass, singing, and coming together over a meal. The Hospitality group will have breakfast in the parish hall following Mass for each of us to come together and celebrate the wonders of our faith found so beautifully in our Blessed Mother. Take time this week to read about Our Lady of Guadalupe. It is a beautiful story and is another way to prepare for the coming of Jesus during this Advent. *Gay Snell*

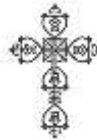
The Saint John Paul II Adoration Chapel
