Happy First Week of Advent!

- On Thursday the Church celebrates the feast of St. Nicholas- *Many Catholic children around the world celebrate St. Nicholas' day! It is said that there were three poor girls that could not get married because they had no dowry, and St. Nicholas came and secretly left three purses of gold for them at night. So the tradition of leaving out shoes to be filled with gifts was born of a generous stranger leaving presents for those in need.* - check out www.catholicicing.com for more info and ideas. Students will be learning about St. Nicholas in class this week. Be sure to ask them about what they learned!
- Students will be given an Advent calendar with daily scripture verses and challenges. We encourage families to hang up the calendar and use it as a tool to prepare for Advent.
- Saturday is the **Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception**, a Holy Day of Obligation where we celebrate Mary and how she was without sin even at the moment of her conception thanks to the grace given to her by God. Make sure to attend Friday's Vigil Mass at 6:30 pm or the 8 am or 10am Mass on Saturday. Students will need to fill out a blue sheet and turn it in for Saturday's Holy Day.



LITURGY CORNER

December 8 is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception and a Holy Day of Obligation. We know that Jesus was conceived without Original Sin—he is God and therefore cannot sin or have sin. We celebrate the Immaculate Conception of Mary, his Mother. Because she was chosen by Jesus to be his mother she was preserved from the first moment of her conception from original sin and was filled with grace from the very beginning of her life. The Church has always believed in Mary's Immaculate Conception both in the East and in the West. We see in Luke's Gospel...Hail Mary, full of grace... In 1846 she was proclaimed the patroness of the United States under this title and remains so to this day. In 1854 the dogma was defined by Pope Pius IX and her feast day has been celebrated as a Holy Day ever since. Between February 11 and July 16, 1858, Our Lady appeared to 14 year old Bernadette Soubirous 18 times in a grotto near Lourdes, France. In her last appearance she told Saint Bernadette, “I am the Immaculate Conception,” something young Bernadette would have not known, making her visions credible to the people of her time. On her 9th visit she had Saint Bernadette dig in the ground, and an underground fountain appeared that still provides healing baths. By her “yes” at the Annunciation, the disobedience of Eden is undone, and paradise is possible for each of us. Even though this Holy Day falls on a Saturday, it is obligatory—because Mother Mary is the patroness of the United States. *Gay Snell*
