### Happy 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Advent

**This week we celebrate many feast days.** Tomorrow evening we begin our **Christmas** celebration with the last day of Posadas (the Children’s Play at 5:00 pm), Vigil Masses at 5:30 pm at San Clemente and 7:00 pm at San Antonio. Then we enter into Christmas, **The Nativity of the Lord, with Midnight Mass and Adoration of the Christ Child.** We begin our 8-day celebration—the Octave of Christmas—with Christmas Masses during the day. Our Christmas celebration continues for 8 days culminating with the **Feast of Mary, Mother of God** on January 1. On Wednesday, December 26, we celebrate the **Feast of Saint Stephen, the First Martyr.** He was one of the first seven deacons of the Church. He was charged with helping to distribute alms and was a man “filled with grace and power” who preached and “worked great wonders and signs

among the people.” **Thursday is the Feast of Saint John, Apostle and Evangelist.** He is identified in his Gospel simply as the “disciple whom Jesus loved.” He was the only Apostle who remained at the foot of the cross and to whom Jesus entrusted his Blessed Mother. Friday is the **Feast of the Holy Innocents, Martyrs.** Saint Matthew tells us that when King Herod heard from the Magi that a new king of the Jews had been born, “he was greatly troubled” (2:3). Herod had all male children under the age of two brutally slaughtered in and around Bethlehem. *Blessed Christmas, Gay Snell*
