## LITURGY CORNER

Yesterday we celebrated the Presentation of the Lord. Mary and Joseph present their newborn Child in the Temple out of obedience to the law. It is also known as Candlemas and the day when candles are blessed. Today is primarily the Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time but also the feast of Saint Blaise. It is believed that Saint Blaise saved a young boy from choking to death. He was martyred in 316 for refusing to sacrifice to pagan idols. It is traditional to have our throats blessed on his feast day.

Flu season is here again and because of that the Archdiocese has asked us not to share in the Sign of Peace, not receive the Precious Blood, and receive Holy Communion on our hands. These omissions, if you will, in no way invalidate Holy Mass nor make it illicit. Eucharist is a Sacrament instituted by Jesus. All sacraments have form and matter. In the case of the Eucharist, the matter is the wheat bread and grape wine and the form is the words of consecration-This is my Body, This is my Blood. The only way the Eucharist can be invalid is if one of these is tampered with; for example, we purchase hosts or wine made with other ingredients or the celebrant changes the words of consecration. The intention of the celebrant is also important in a valid Mass; in other words, he intends with the Eucharistic Prayer to follow the teachings of Jesus and by means of his ordination the bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus. God set things up so it's almost impossible for a Mass to be invalid. A licit Mass is one where the rubrics (the words of explanation in red) are followed. A Mass can become illicit, illegal, if there are liturgical abuses. (Safeguarding each other from the flu is not a liturgical abuse.) However, as long as everything is in place sacramentally during the Eucharistic Prayer, the Mass is still valid. *Gay Snell*
