LITURGY CORNER

Today is the Baptism of the Lord and the end of the Christmas Season. Tomorrow we enter into Ordinary Time. This season is the shorter of the two and will lead us into the Season of Lent. The colors will change to green. The Baptism of the Lord is the time when Jesus joined those going out to see John the Baptist. He went in the gesture of repentance, not because there is sin in him, but to make it possible for us to share in his relationship with the Father. It is his example that we follow in our sacramental life. It here that we see clearly the Trinitarian Mystery and also when Jesus began his public ministry. Our liturgy will follow Jesus in the Readings leading up to Ash Wednesday at the Wedding at Cana, on the road as he heals and teaches, and as he gathers his followers. We are called to follow Jesus' example as we baptize our children, stay close to Jesus in the Eucharist, and in service to the Church. If you are involved in a liturgical ministry or any other ministry within the parish, God bless you. If you are not and are looking for a way to be of service, there are many ministries in which you can serve. Liturgical ministries include Lectors—those who proclaim the 1st and 2nd Readings, Extra-ordinary Ministers of Holy Communion—those we assist with the distribution of Holy Communion, Choir members—those who lead the assembly in song, Altar Servers—those who assist in the Sanctuary, and Usher/Greeters-those who greet at the doors, assist if needed, and take up the collection. *Have a good week in the Lord, Gay Snell*
