Did you attend Easter Vigil? Did you experience the joy and excitement of those coming into the Roman Catholic Church? Did you want that for yourself? As baptized Catholics we can experience Easter Vigil not only at Holy Mass but in our daily lives. We are called to live out our baptism every day. For those who are not yet fully initiated into the Church—the unbaptized, those baptized but who have not received First Eucharist or Confirmation, and those baptized into another Christian faith who are interested in the Catholic Church—there is the opportunity to experience Easter Vigil. *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults*, for those 18 or older, is a series of rites, conducted in the context of learning about the faith and spiritual formation. Through this formation a person is fully incorporated into the Body of Christ, the Roman Catholic Church.

LITURGY CORNER

With the Vatican II documents came changes to the liturgy. The *Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy's* first requirement was that all the faithful be led to a full and active part in liturgical celebrations and that the clergy be better instructed. It stated that the rites should be short, clear and unencumbered. Latin was obviously the great obstacle to this ideal, but it was agreed upon that the vernacular of the people could be used to a greater extent, especially in administering the sacraments. The *Constitution* placed a new emphasis on the Mass as both a sacrifice and a communal meal. Returning to the early practice, the Altar was turned so that the celebrant faced the people. Other reforms included the introduction of Holy Communion under both Species. It restored the catechumenate for adults and recommended that Extreme Unction be renamed Anointing of the Sick. Composers and artists were encouraged to enrich the Church's worship with their talents. Wherever possible, congregations should join in worship by singing. The liturgical changes took immediate effect. During the years following Vatican II, more liturgical reforms have been introduced. Notable among these are the permanent diaconate, the participation of lay Eucharistic ministers and readers, and the option to receive the Sacred Body in the hand. Today we continue to see the benefits of liturgical reform. Lay participation in the liturgy is certainly greater than in former days, and the use of the vernacular has brought wider knowledge of both liturgy and Scripture. Through Vatican II we have been given the tools to become more involved in the liturgy. We are called to full and active participation...
