#### LITURGY CORNER

Stations of the Cross is a form of devotion commemorating the Passion and death of Jesus. It is also called the "Way of the Cross". Images of the 14 Stations are mounted in most, if not all, Roman Catholic churches, as well as chapels and are often found outdoors. A person making the Way of the Cross passes and/or stops at each Station for meditation. When there is a group of people, the leader walks from Station to Station, as we do on all Fridays of Lent. (A plenary indulgence is granted to the faithful who make the stations, under the usual conditions: freedom from all attachment to sin, reception of the sacraments of penance and the Eucharist, and prayers for the intentions of the pope.) The Stations of the Cross originated remotely from the practice of Holy Land pilgrims who visited the actual sites-the Via Dolorosa. By the 5th century the Way of the Cross out of the Holy Land had become practice. By the 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> centuries the connection became a strong devotion to the Passion of Christ. Franciscans, who were given custody of the holy places in 1342, promoted the devotion widely; one of them, St. Leonard of Port Maurice, became known as the greatest preacher of the Way of the Cross in the

18<sup>th</sup> century. The current practice and features of this devotion were fixed by Pope Clement XII in 1731. (Plenary indulgence—A way to reduce the amount of punishment one has to undergo for sins. It does not replace the Sacrament of Penance or the forgiveness given, but rather lessens or removes the temporal punishment due to sin.) *Gay Snell*
