Lent is a time to learn more about our Faith. It is a time to become more involved in our Faith. During Lent, there are many devotions in which to participate. Perhaps you can attend daily Mass or sit with Our Lord for an hour either Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday from 12:00 to 1:00, or an hour on Friday. Our Lord will be there waiting for us after the Morning Mass until time for the Evening Mass every Friday of Lent. Stations of the Cross will take place on Fridays after Mass. And this year Father Jim and the Deacons will be having Soup and Scripture in the parish hall following the Stations. The topic will be "Lent and the Capital Sins". Maybe this Lent would be a good time to consider participating in a Liturgical Ministry. Lent is always a good time for the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
