LITURGY CORNER

I found an article I would like to share: What's an advent anyway? Toward the end of December comes the shortest day of the year. There's a lot of darkness. There's very little light. But then – things begin to turn round. The days get a little longer. All over this earth, through all time, peoples held celebrations when the sun was reborn, when there was even a little more light. They knew what this promised! And that's why we have Christmas on December 25. The peoples who became Christians in the first years were used to a celebration at that time of year – the birthday party of the sun, earth's best friend. But Jesus was the light of the world, just like the sun. And so it became his birthday anniversary. Advent is a way of keeping those darkest days of the year as a preparation. All the things we are afraid of are remembered in Advent - because it is so dark and being afraid of the dark is our most basic fear. All the others - economic, political, social, family, health, death – are in that big one. And all the way through Advent we hear scriptures that say BE COMFORT-ED and DON'T BE AFRAID! (And on Christmas, those are the first words spoken to the shepherds.) Advent is the season of God's promises. 
