# Warning about Texting/Email Scams asking for money that use the names of parishes, priests and parishioners:

**NOR** will I ever do that. If you receive a text or an email that says it is from me or the parish asking for money, do not respond to it! BUT, if this happens to you, please let me know so that I can be aware it and can notify the diocese to get the type of scam message out to the public. Also, we can get the telephone number of the text, or the email address to local law enforcement, and the South Dakota Attorney General's Office to investigate it.

It appears that these scammers are using parish websites to obtain names and numbers, as some parish websites have listed names, telephone numbers and email addresses of members to assist inter-parish communications. St. Simon and Jude parish <u>NEVER</u> publishes personal information of parishioners on our website. God Bless you, *Fn. Doug Binsfeld* 

"<u>Some example [scam] messages include:</u> (actual names found in the texts have been replaced with fictitious names):

'Hi Jacob, May the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you always. I need your assistance, Please get back to me as soon as possible. Thanks Fr. Fulton Sheen.'

'I actually need to surprise some cancer patients in the hospital by giving them the Word & Google Play gift card. Are you able to get this for me now. Thanks Fr. Fulton Sheen.'

'Okay, no problem. If tomorrow works its fine you have at it done at your convenient time. I need Google Play Gift Card in \$50 (5) & \$100 (5) denominations. Once you get the cards, scratch the back off and take a picture of the code. Just send me the codes and you can skip dropping the cards off at the parish. Thanks Fr. Fulton Sheen.'

"The messages give the appearance to the recipient that their pastor is texting them to ask for a financial "gift" for a specific purpose. ... Beyond personal vigilance, recipients can help by informing the public and law enforcement about this scheme. Therefore, already numerous reports have been made to the Better Business Bureau and to the <u>South Dakota Attorney General's Office (605)773-4400."</u> (Matt Althoff, Chancellor of the Sioux Falls Catholic Diocese)



There have been many reports of both email and texting scams happening within parishes of the diocese this past week. Parishioners have been receiving text messages and emails claiming to be from their pastor asking for assistance. The emails and texts were sent from unknown accounts. However, the use of the pastor's name caused individuals to believe it was, in fact, "Father" who was reaching out to them. Unfortunately some parishioners have lost money to this scam as they were tricked into purchasing gift cards for a fake cause. At the encouragement of the SD Attorney General's Office, we urge all parishioners to be mindful: Father Doug and the parish office will never ask for money or gift cards via text message or email. If you receive a text or email

asking for money or gift cards, you should always call the parish office to verify. You can also report it to the SD Attorney General's office at 1-800-300-1986. Their office is investigating this scam.
