## PLARNERS UNITE! JANUARY 12, 9 - 11 a.m.

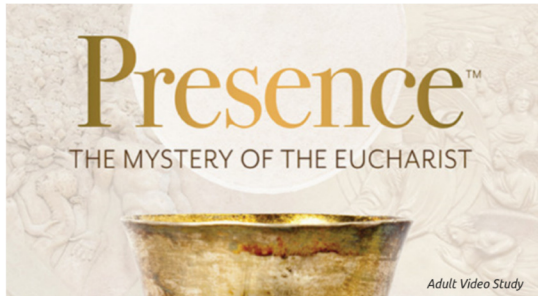

## TUITION ASSISTANCE FOR 2019/2020 SCHOOL YEAR

The Catholic Education Foundation, the Archdiocese of Louisville and the funding partners are helping more families than ever who cannot afford the full cost of educating their children in a Catholic elementary school. All families with one or more children enrolled in or applying to a Catholic elementary school may apply.

Tuition assistance applications should be submitted between **December 15, 2018 and February 28, 2019**. A single form, the FACTS management application, will be used for all forms of Catholic elementary school tuition assistance. Families must use the online application on our website, [www.ceflou.org](http://www.ceflou.org).

To make the application process easier for families, you will submit your **2017** federal income tax return and **2017** W-2 information. Your 2017 tax information will not be required.

You must reapply for tuition assistance every year. Award letters will be mailed to families no later than June 15, 2019.
