

ST. BERNARD REOPENING

As per the guidelines set forth by Governor Beshear, St. Bernard will be allowing in person meetings up to 50 people, or up to the capacity of the room beginning June 29. The All Saints Room will be available to groups of up to 10 people. With offices being moved, approximately half of the Checkerboard Room is available for meetings of up to 25 people. Masks will be required for everyone attending the meeting and the six-foot social distancing mandate remains in effect. Encourage use of hand sanitizer upon entering and leaving the facility. Each group will be responsible for disinfecting the room after the meeting using the guidelines and materials that will be provided.
