Dear St. Bernard Family,

At the direction of Archbishop Joseph Kurtz and Governor Andy Beshear we are immediately suspending the practice of public weekday and weekend Masses until we get permission to pray together again. I know that this decision did not happen in an alarmed way, but after careful listening to the solid advice of medical professionals. Know that I will be celebrating Mass daily for you and your needs privately.

I ask you to use this time to pray daily for those who are putting their health and lives at risk in the medical field and as first responders. We also need to pray for families and individuals who may suffer because of reduced hourly wages and / or having to care for the feeding and tending of school children who are now at home. Pray especially for our elderly and physically vulnerable neighbors; that this virus avoids them. Pray for those who are trying to find a cure or a vaccine to combat the COVID-19 virus; may God guide their work.

There are many good ways, including The Faith Channel, where you can watch or video the weekend Mass on the Air. Also, the U.S. Catholic Conference of Bishops and other websites have the daily readings available to read or listen to online. You can always pray the Rosary or the Stations of the Cross at home.

We have had a great response to our request for grocery gift cards. We are compiling a list of families with school children and elderly/homebound parishioners that may need us to bring them groceries during this tough time. Our school and parish staff will help buy and deliver those necessities over the next few weeks. If you know of a parishioner that may need a little help please call the parish office (239-5178) and make us aware of their need.

All parish group gatherings and meetings are cancelled until further notified. We will make a decision soon about whether we will even continue to have carry out or drive through Fish Fry. That decision will be posted on our Facebook pages. But, we will not have dining in the gym until further notified. If you have questions about whether the group or ministry activity that you would normally attend is also cancelled, please call the staff person or committee chairperson of that activity to find out. This will also mean our maintenance day, that we had scheduled for next Saturday, will be postponed until later. While we are closed down we will have all of our facilities and furniture disinfected and cleaned professionally.

Our offices will have someone here to answer the phones from 8 AM - 1 PM each weekday (239-5178). Otherwise, our offices are closed for daily activities. If there is an emergency please feel free to call the cell phone numbers of me (502) 594-2077, our pastoral associate, Denise Meyer, (502) 262-7223, or our business manager, Jim Parr (502) 468-3719.

A final reminder, our bills don't stop even if we do not have Mass. Please remember to send us your pledged tithe via the mail since you will not be able to drop it into the collection basket. This may be a good time to set up online giving to our parish through our WeShare portal on our parish website. It makes your giving to our parish one less thing you have to think about. And, the options on how much and how often you wish to give are totally up to you. I do it and I won't do it any other way since trying it.

Please know that I am honored and humbled to be your pastor. I pray for you daily. If there is anything or anyone that you want me to attend to, please call me, Denise or Jim.
