TAX INCENTIVES FOR YEAR END GIVING

"BLESSED TO BE A BLESSING" Capital Campaign



Want to bless your family in 2021 and, while you're at it, bless both your parish and school this year?

Last year, due to the pandemic, Congress passed the CARES ACT and then reaffirmed it again in what is called the Consolidated Tax Relief Bill.

Both bills are designed to encourage charitable giving to qualified charities like St. Bernard Parish and/or the St. Bernard Parish and School "Blessed to Be a Blessing" capital campaign. The bill allows a taxpayer to receive a dollar-for-dollar reduction in their AGI (adjusted gross income) or the amount of your taxable income for 2021.

Further, this bill expanded the limit on the deductibility of cash contributions made by individuals to a public charity during 2021 from 60% of adjusted gross income to 100% of adjusted gross income. Essentially, for every dollar you give to St. Bernard in 2021, you reduce your taxable income by that same amount.

As with any tax-related questions, St. Bernard's leaders encourage you to speak with your financial advisor or tax accountant for details as to how this rare action by Congress could be beneficial both to you and to your favorite charity...which we hope is St. Bernard. Think of this as an opportunity to make a special gift to St. Bernard's regular offertory, or to St. Bernard's School, or you might be thinking about fulfilling a portion or all of your pledge to the BLESSED TO BE A BLESSING capital campaign by giving a portion or all of your pledge total before the end of this year 2021. Donations need to be received in the office by noon on December 29.
