Pope Francis named Father William M. Joensen, Ph.D., a priest of the Archdiocese of Dubuque, as the 10th bishop for the Diocese of Des Moines. His ordination as a bishop and installation in the Diocese of Des Moines will be Friday, Sept. 27. Bishop-elect Joensen, age 59, grew up in Ames, the oldest of five children. He attended Iowa State University, earned a degree in zoology and was in medical school when he discerned a calling to the priesthood. He was ordained in 1989 and served in parish ministry for six years before beginning graduate studies in philosophy. Since returning to the Archdiocese of Dubuque, he has served at Loras College in Dubuque as a professor of philosophy and assisted at parishes in and around Dubuque.

June 27th 2019 BUILDING AND GROUNDS COMMITTEE MEETING:

The Meeting of the Building and Grounds Committee was held on June 27, 7:00 P.M. in the bank conference room.

1. Call Meeting to order. Present: Steve Kenkel, Mike Evers, Todd Langenfeld, Fr. Dan, Marcy Muenchrath, Mike Tremel. Members Absent: Kathy Frederick, Ron Tremel, Dave Kramer, Chris Gaul representing Finance Council.
2. Approve Agenda: Marcy made a motion to approve the agenda, Mike E. seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously
3. **Old Business** Update on new storage shed, electrical, plumbing and heating. Ceiling and walls will be built in big area. No plumbing will be added at this time. After walls are up we will add some outlets, lights and heat if needed. Update on tuckpointing and church roof repairs. Andrew Tuckpointing and Elevate Roofing will coordinate together their work together in the next few months. Andrew Tuckpointing's bid is \$7,000 to repair the mortar joints, tuckpointing as needed and water-proofing. Elevate Roofing will provide roofing products and sheet metal fabrication as needed. Their bid totaled \$4,500. We may have additional cost when they actually get in there to see the damages. There are 4 areas of concern on the church: an active leak in the southeast corner of the bell tower furnace room east balcony north of window a leak between window suspect the north corner has a leak.
4. **New Business**
5. Replacement of concrete parking lot, final section will be replaced yet this summer. This cost will be \$20,000. The rectory windows need some attention. The bathroom and 2 bedroom windows will need looked at soon and Gene Wilwerding could look it all over to see if there are any other places need attention. The furnace exhaust has a low spot that must gather condensation causing issues in the winter of freezing. Kloewer's will be asked to come take a look at it. Election of chair and vice-chair. Steve Kenkel and Todd Langenfeld will be stepping down as the chair and vice-chair respectively. Both gentlemen have stated they will remain on the board but not in office. Kathy Frederick will be resigning. The discussion has begun about finding new chairs and replacing Kathy on the Committee

5. Next Meeting is tentatively scheduled for Sept 5th.
