1. Call Meeting to order and opening prayer by Fr. Dan

2. Approve Agenda: Steve made a motion to approve the agenda, Mike seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

3. Old Business

Handicap ramp NE door of old rectory – Greg Brasel will be pouring the concrete for a ramp on the "back door" to the rectory. The concrete will cost approx. \$1500. This does not include labor or handrails.

Wifi in Church – It is up and running.

4. New Business

East portion of north parapet bid – Bid for East and West portions of the north parapet and steeple \$43,095. This work will start approx. September or October. This is an ongoing project that we would request each year. A motion to request Parish Council to approve a portion to be fixed was made by Steve and Ron seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Bid for large west window on church – still working on these bids

Carpet replacement on outdoor front stairs of church – Cristie will check into a commercial grade carpet from Hinline Furniture in Harlan

Concrete wall in front of church property – Dave will check into getting someone to power wash it.
