There will be no Exercise Class or Tai Chi Class on Friday, August 7th.

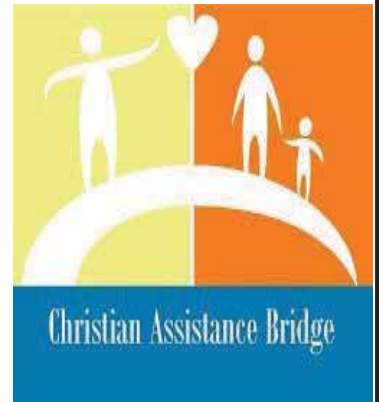

VIRTUAL PARTICIPATION IN SUNDAY MASS WITH COMMUNION - IN SCHOOL CARPOOL LINE

If you are uncomfortable being in public spaces, consider attending Sunday Mass while in your car.

You are invited to park in the school carpool line and parking areas and tune in to the Mass through your phone or electronic device at <https://www.facebook.com/stjneumann/>.

At the end of the live Mass, the communion ministers will proceed to the breezeway at the entrance of the school to distribute Communion to those who have been watching the Mass in the school parking lot. You will be directed to drive around the circle in a single line to the covered walkway, stopping one at a time where the ministers are standing. A minister for each side of the car will provide Communion in the hand through the window. If it is not practical for all to get to a window (three rows of seats in a van, for example), the family can open the door and/or step out of the car to receive. All in the car are required to wear masks when receiving Communion.

Once those in the first car have received, please drive on and allow the next car to come to the communion station.

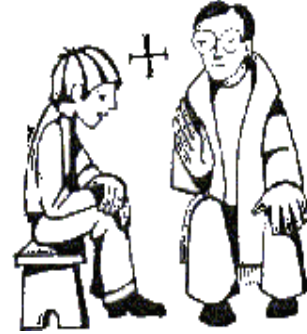

LUGAR: Salón de los adolescentes (Teen Room)

PROTOCOLOS:

- El penitente ingresara al edificio a través de la cafetería, escoltado por un ministro de hospitalidad, se desinfectara las manos y será llevado a las últimas filas de la iglesia del gimnasio para esperar hasta que el sacerdote esté disponible.
- El penitente permanecerá sentado allí hasta que sea invitado a proceder al teen room.
- Tanto el sacerdote como el penitente deben usar máscaras.
- El penitente se sienta en una silla simple detrás de una pantalla (para confesión anónima) o en otra silla a 6 pies de distancia (para confesión cara a cara).
- Toallitas desinfectantes estarán disponibles para que el penitente pueda limpiar la silla antes de sentarse.
- Después de completar el sacramento con el sacerdote, el penitente sale del edificio por las puertas del pasillo de la escuela y puede hacer penitencia afuera o puede ser acompañado de regreso al gimnasio a través de la cafetería, para sentarse a rezar ante el Santísimo Sacramento.

PARTICIPACIÓN VIRTUAL EN MISA DE DOMINGO CON COMUNIÓN

- EN LA LÍNEA DONDE SE RECOGEN LOS NIÑOS DE LA ESCUELA

Si se siente incómodo en espacios públicos, considere asistir a la misa dominical desde su automóvil.

Usted está invitado a estacionarse en la línea de donde se recogen los niños de la escuela y sintonizar la misa a través de su teléfono o dispositivo electrónico en <https://www.facebook.com/stjneumann/>.

Al final de la Misa en vivo, los ministros de la comunión procederán a la entrada de la escuela para distribuir la Comunión a aquellos que han estado viendo la Misa en el estacionamiento de la escuela.

Si eres nuevo en nuestra área, te invitamos a registrarte con nosotros. Los formularios de inscripción para nuevos miembros están disponibles en los estantes de exhibición en la iglesia, en nuestro sitio web y en la oficina parroquial.

Se requiere membresía parroquial para:

- Recibir los Sacramentos de Bautismo, Primera Comunión, Confirmación, Matrimonio.
- Celebrar misa de quince años.

Bautismo: Comuníquese con la oficina para registrarse para la preparación del bautismo con al menos 3 meses de anticipación. Las familias deben estar registradas por lo menos 6 meses antes de la fecha del Bautismo. Se requiere la asistencia de dos clases de bautismo para los padres y padrinos. Proveer copia del certificado de nacimiento del que va a ser bautizado e identificación de los padres y padrinos. Padrinos deben ser católicos practicantes y deben presentar fe de bautismo, primera comunión y confirmación y si son casados deben presentar acta de matrimonio por la Iglesia. Si los padrinos **no son miembros** de St John Neumann deben traer una carta de la iglesia de la cual son miembros, que confirme que son miembros activos y que cualifiquen para ser padrinos.

Primera Comunión y Confirmación: Deben comunicarse a la oficina y preguntar por Veronica Carneiro o Johnny Sanchez.

Matrimonio: Todas las parejas que deseen casarse tienen que comenzar el proceso de preparación con un año de anticipación. Favor de comunicarse con María Correa a la oficina lo antes posible.

Quinceañeras: Llamar a la oficina para comenzar con el proceso con 9 meses a 1 año de anticipación. La quinceañera debe haber hecho la Primera Comunión, y debe estar en el primer o segundo año de Confirmación. Debe estar participando en el grupo juvenil y asistir a misa regularmente. **Si reúnes estos requisitos** entonces comunícate con María Correa.

INFORMACION IMPORTANTE:

Bringing Communion Home



If you have family members who need to shelter in place and cannot come to Mass, you may bring them Holy Communion. In order to do so, you must have a pyx in which to carry it. It is usually carried reverently in a small wallet called a burse, and is taken directly home after Mass.

Cautions:

Do not attend any of these liturgies if you:

- are sick in any way
- are over the age of 65
- are pregnant or recently pregnant (in last 2 weeks)
- have a compromised immunity
- have diabetes, liver/ kidney/heart disease (e.g., high blood pressure, congestive heart failure)
- have lung or breathing problems
- have neurological/neuro-developmental conditions (e.g., cerebral palsy, epilepsy, and stroke)
- have any other risk factor for developing a more severe case of COVID-19

Dispensation

While Bishop Guglielmone is allowing public celebration of Masses, he has also extended the dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass. You are not obligated to come to Mass. We will also continue to provide a video of Sunday Mass for those who will not be attending Mass in person.

Children

Children are more likely to be asymptomatic carriers of the virus. They are more likely to want to use the bathroom, have difficulty maintaining social distancing and keeping their masks in place. It may be wise to have children stay at home, especially young children.

Reserve a Seat

In accordance with the guidelines issued by the Diocese to maintain social distancing, you will need a reservation to attend Sunday Mass. Please call the parish office (788-0811) before Thursday at 12:30 p.m. to reserve the number of seats needed for your family. Once seats are filled, you will be given a seat for the next weekend's Mass ahead of anyone else. We can accommodate 130 people per Mass. If we fill the 10:00 a.m. Mass quickly and there are more people who want to attend, we will add a Mass on Saturday at 5:15 p.m. Currently, you do not need to reserve a seat for daily Mass.

Procedures

Doors will be open for entry 30 minutes before the start of Mass. **We will require congregants to wear masks for the entirety of their time on the campus and during Mass. We ask everyone to use hand sanitizer immediately upon entry.** After your name is checked off in the breezeway, you will be led to your seats by a staff member through the cafeteria a few at a time to maintain social distancing. Unfortunately, you will not be able to choose your own seat and you are not allowed to change seats once seated. You will remain there for the entire Mass. Once Mass begins, latecomers will not be allowed entry. Words for songs, readings, or other prayers will be projected on a screen as we do at school Masses.

Holy Communion

Bishop Guglielmone and other experts have suggested that Communion can be distributed as people depart from Mass rather than at the normal time. We will distribute at the end of Mass to minimize movement of people during Mass. After the final

blessing, staff members will dismiss one row at a time through doors into the hallway. Do not leave your row until instructed to do so. Once in the hallway, use hand sanitizer and maintain six feet of distance between you and others.

Communion ministers will be outside in the breezeway. They will be wearing mask and will place the host in your hand without touching your hand. They will have hand sanitizer with them in the event they touch someone. The communicant receives while still wearing his or her mask, then moves away, lowers the mask, and consumes the host.

Communion must be received **in the hand—not** on the tongue. There will be no exceptions to this.

After receiving Communion, we ask that you proceed to your vehicle immediately and refrain from congregating in the parking lot.

Cleaning Procedures

Public Masses will take place in the school gym to make it easier to clean and disinfect after each Mass. We will use a professional company for cleaning of chairs and all utilized spaces, including bathrooms. However, we will only be able to clean bathrooms between Masses and not after each use. We are committed to making the thoroughness of our cleaning very robust out of a concern for safety.

(before Thursday noon Mass)

Thursday 6:00 p.m. to 6:45 p.m.

(before Thursday 7 p.m. Mass)

LOCATION: Teen Room

PROTOCOLS:

Enter the building through the cafeteria, escorted by a minister of hospitality, sanitize your hands as usual, and go to the last rows of the gym church to wait until the priest is available.

Please remain seated there until invited to proceed to the Teen Room.

Take a sanitizing wipe to wipe down the chair before sitting down.

Both priest and penitent must wear masks.

Sit in a chair behind a screen (for anonymous confession) or in another chair 6 feet away (for face-to-face confession).

After completing the sacrament with the priest, exit the building through the school hallway doors.

Complete your penance outside in a devotional area, or return to the cafeteria doors to be escorted back the cafeteria, to sit pray before the Blessed Sacrament and stay for Mass.

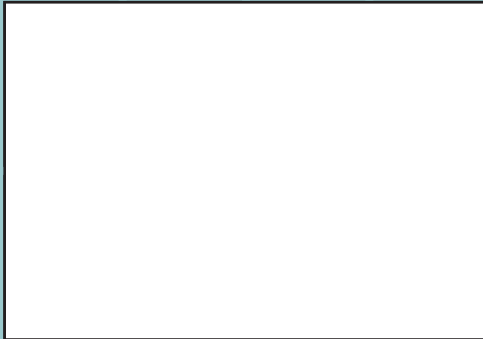

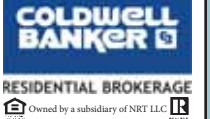
