

Welcome to Church of the Annunciation

The other day I was in conversation with someone regarding a number of Church related traditions, from the blessing of throats, February 3, to the liturgical season of Lent. During my conversation with him I realized that people's understanding of Church is really limited. It seems that people's faith depends a lot on their limited understanding and interpretation of Church traditions, teachings and doctrines. So many people seem to fall back on the elementary understanding they received when they were children. I noticed that his recollection of childhood traditions are pretty fragmented, because it has remained on such an elementary level. It is not that these traditions are not important, but if this is the extent of our understanding of faith, we really limit our development of God's work in us and through us.

With just two weeks before Lent I encourage those of you who have not signed up for FORMED to please do so to invite a better understanding of this liturgical season. During the conversation I had with this young man, he brought up Lent and how he would like to develop a better understanding of the journey. All that he could remember was that his parents asked him and his siblings to give things up and that he could not eat meat on Fridays. When I asked him about the reasoning of this tradition he had no idea, even after thirty years of trying to figure out what he would give up each Lent. I am not saying that all of us are at such an elementary state of faith, but most of us miss the opportunity we have during Lent to grow into Easter people. Yes, sacrifice is important for all of us, but how does that translate into an understanding of what needs to happen during our journey of faith. I am inviting all of us to be more informed about Lenten customs and traditions, not ignoring what we have learned in the past, but inviting them to help me be more. I encourage everyone, again, be involved in the FORMED process, and also to participate in prayer, fasting and almsgiving, taking us into parts of a desert journey one has never been before. These six weeks may also be a time to educate oneself through reading, group discussion or prayer opportunities. Again, having had this discussion I don't judge him for not having taken time to grow with the Lord, but I certainly want to challenge him, and all of us, to make these six weeks a memorable journey of faith.
